

“Filming without Camera”

Uruzgan is one of the poorest provinces of Afghanistan. Its population has been deprived from any basic facilities for many years.

The Dutch Consortium for Uruzgan (DCU), a partnership of five Dutch aid organizations, works in Uruzgan already for many years and achieved a lot of promising results. DCA-VET is one of the five partners.

A Dutch film crew, Hans Stakelbeek and Annemieke Veltman, went to Uruzgan in 2012 to picture the situation of the people in Uruzgan. They documented the often difficult circumstances that the population of Uruzgan has to deal with day in day out (e.g. drugs addiction, gender inequality, violence, and lack of medical care services). Of course, also the development aid workers in the province have to deal with this reality.

This 17 minutes documentary shows how DCU combines the different strengths of each individual aid organization, and how they work together with the local partners and inhabitants to alleviate these harsh problems. A documentary that reflects living between fear and hope in Uruzgan.
